Summary:

Total revenue for the month of October was **\$7,937.90.** The top income generators for the month of October:

- 1. Spirit Store Sales: \$3,783.11
- 2. Membership Revenue: \$2,410.55
- 3. Advertising (Sports Programs): \$1,385.55
- 4. Miscellaneous Income (Bank): \$333.69
- 5. Miscellaneous Income (Yard Signs): \$25.00

Total Expenses for the month of June was **\$4,524.60**. Top expenses for the month of September:

- 1. Spirit Store: \$1,872.00
- 2. Girls Soccer: \$663.85
- 3. Girls Basketball: \$463.50
- 4. Boys Soccer: \$434.60

- 5. Girls Cross Country: \$387.00
- 6. Hockey: \$300.00
- 7. Concessions: \$128.25
- 8. Girls Tennis: \$108.00

October reflects a slower period in revenue, with the Spirit Store as the primary income source, followed by membership revenue and sports program advertising. The income from the bank is interest income in our money market savings account.

On the expense side the Spirit store bought inventory which often is our largest expense. We also paid for senior gifts and end of the year parties for sports teams. Girls basketball and hockey received some of their preseason equipment / coaches gear.

The total assets as of October 31, 2024 is **\$118,537.57**; this represents a decrease in assets of **(\$6,780.02)** from October 2024. For comparison, at this point last year (October 2024), we had **\$126,204.49** in assets.

Need to start thinking about whether boosters wants to be responsible for selling sponsors. And then we would keep money to pay for sports equipment and scholarships.
